Tony Michell is currently Managing Director of Korea Associates Business Consultancy, a visiting Professor at KDI School of Public Policy and Management and Research Director of the One Million Jobs Initiative. He is the leader of the Korea Business Forum a monthly group of 60 business leaders and diplomats which discusses issues related to the economic, social and political development of Korea and the management issues related to operating in Korea.

A Cambridge Ph.D holder he has taught economic development and change management in the UK, US and Korea. First coming to Korea in 1978 he worked as an economic planner in the Economic Planning Bureau of the Economic Planning Board and subsequently worked as a consultant to the World Bank, ILO and UNDP. In the mid 1980s he was project economist on some of Korea's first overseas aid projects.

His ideas about the economic development of Northeast Asia have been published in KIEP's Northeast Asia Economic Development Report in successive years, 2013, 2014 and 2016.

Recent publications include The One Million Jobs Initiative 2016 and Samsung Electronics and the Struggle for Leadership in the Electronics Industry, 2010. Forthcoming publications include Samsung vs Apple, the Struggle for Leadership Round II
