Head of the Friedrich Naumann Foundation for Freedom Korea office

Lars-André Richter is the Head of the Friedrich Naumann Foundation for Freedom Korea office since June 2012. He studied amongst others German Literature, Philosophy and History in Tübingen, Leipzig, Paris (Paris III – Sorbonne Nouvelle) and Berlin. He earned his PhD from Humboldt University in Berlin in 2008 with doctoral dissertation on the Weimar Republic.
